Service Projects:

Past Service Projects Conducted:

- 08 Sept. 2016 - Interfaith Partnership for the Promotion of Responsible Parenthood. Summit on Teen Pregnancy, HIV/AIDS and Family Planning @ Ynares Center, Antipolo City.**
- 24 Sept. 2016 - In cooperation with Barangay Sta. Cruz, Antipolo City and Kanlungan ng Kabataan where children in conflict with law, abandoned little girls and boys and abused girls are housed, conducted talks, spiritual and inspiration guidance.**
- 17 Nov. 2016 - Pre-natal (“Buntis Day”) at Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City, as part of its “Abot Kamay na may Pagmamahal, Zonta sa Barangay” project initiative, Zonta Club of Antipolo (ZCA) in coordination with Brgy. San Roque Health Center through the Office of the Barangay Chairman and Council, extended its care to pregnant women (maternal care) and made them aware that abuses of physical, mental, emotional and financial should not be allowed.**
- 29 Nov. 2016 - VAWC Forum with Acid testing and breast examination held at Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City as part (2) of the “Abot Kamay na ay Pagmamahal sa Barangay” project initiative. RA 7610 and**

RA9262 was discussed at length by PO3 Anna Marie Francisco of PNP Women's Desk.

- 08 March 2017 - As Zonta Club of Antipolo' support to international service ZISVAW, Donated \$140 (7 member attendees) and Pledged \$280 (14 members absent) to Rose Fund.**
- 25 Mar. 2017 - Breast Cancer Awareness Program – under the initiative of Vice-Mayor and Zonta Club of Antipolo's Charter President Josefina G. Gatlabayan, the City Government of Antipolo and Inner Wheels of the Philippines, Zonta Club of Antipolo as partner will spearhead the city-wide campaign on breast cancer aware-ness, extend support to women affected by the disease and to raise funds for research to change the future for others.**
- 28 Mar. 2017 - As an NGO, Zonta Club of Antipolo was called for the 1st Local Health Board meeting Health Forum, where Health caravan in different barangays of Antipolo City was launched including monitoring of undernourished children.**
- 31 Mar. 2017 - 3rd Women's Congress/Serbisyo para kay Juana another activity to celebrate International Women's Day. Strengthening partnerships in the barangays for the elimination of discrimination and violence against women and their children.**

- 11 April 2017 - Abot Kamay na may Pagmamahal, Zonta sa Barangay part 3.**
As our continuing partnership/coordination with Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City, ZCA was present at its “Oplan Tuli (para sa kabataang lalaki) at Libreng Pap smear Check up (para sa kababaihan) project. DOH representative and Barangay Health Officer, Mrs. Chato Ruanto talked about how women should take care of themselves – physically/personal hygiene, emotionally, sexually and spiritually. ZCA took care of the needed supplies for the pap smear check ups, distributed vitamins and health kit (toiletries and pillows and blankets) and served light merienda.
- 18 – 25 June 2017 - As added service to the community, Zonta Club of Antipolo distributed/donated condensed milk/creamer from Alaska Milk Philippines through the sharing courtesy of Zonta Club Mandaluyong San Juan 2 with President Rachel Ruelo and Wading Co initiating. ZCA requested 5000 boxes and was delivered on 18 June 2017.**

2) Current Services Projects

1) Past Advocacy Projects Conducted

- 1.1 To continue and strengthen Zonta's campaign "Zonta says No to Violence Against Women," Zonta Club of Antipolo on 29 November 2016 held a VAWC Forum at Barangay Hall, Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City with PO3 Anna Marie Francisco of PNP Women's Desk speaking on RA 9262 and RA 7610.**

- 1.2 Zonta Club of Antipolo attended the Launching of 16 days of activism - "Zonta says - Unite and End Violence Against Women and Girls" at Plaza Roma, Intramuros, Manila on the 25th day of November 2016 where the partnership of Zonta and PhilPost was also launched.**

- 1.3 Zonta Club of Antipolo was well represented at Area 1's Advocacy Walk - "Unite and End Violence Against Women and Girls" at Quezon Memorial Circle, Quezon City on the 26th day of November 2016.**

2) Current Advocacy Projects

- 2.1 Planning for the November 2017 Area 1 Advocacy Walk in the City of Antipolo as suggested by the Area 1 Director, Luddie T. Marasigan.**
- 2.2 Continue to have active participation as an NGO (ZCA as member of City of Antipolo Development Council, Local Health Board, Pre-selection Committee member of Public-Private Partnership (PPP).**
- 2.3 Organizing seminars and lectures on women empowerment principles with LGU's.**
