Our Club Vision & Mission 2016 - 2018

Club Vision: Zonta Club of Iloilo I, Inc. will be the leader in Iloilo City in empowering women through advocacy and service towards one vision, one mission, one voice, one movement, A season of weaving D.R.E.A.MS.

Club Mission:

Members will experience an engaging, empowering, fun, educational and family oriented club environment which is conducive in empowering themselves and the women and children around them.

For our Tilipunan Community, they are our focus and purpose. We will offer them engaging and empowering projects for them to experience and achieve quality of life in their own means.

For our fellow Zontian's, We will be able to work with them in projects to promote the cause of empowering women through the 16 days activism.

Our Club History

A group of Manila Zontians headed by Mrs. Eugenia Puyat and Justice Cecilia Munoz - Palma gathered a group of Women civic leaders to introduce them to the world of Zonta. Even as an Informal group, not having received its character from Zonta International, this group went about its civic work, serving the community and also enjoying their fellowship.

It was not until 1973 that the formal charter from Zonta International was formally presented by area director, Justice Cecilia Munoz-Palma to Zonta Club of Iloilo City headed by Charter President, Judge Amelia Kalalo-del Rosario. Charter members included Ruth Tirol Cocjin (now Jarantilla), Ofelia Jalandoni, Elma Herradura, Virgilia Domin, Pilar Akol, Simplicia Offemaria, Gloria Magalona and Gloria Tirol.

In 1975, a new set of officers, headed by Ofelia Jalandoni, took over. Ofelia, a noted civic leader, recruited new members from the cream of Iloilo Professionals and business women. At the same time, various civic programs were implemented. Anti-TB drivers, bringing cheers to the aged and orphans of Asilo de Molo, Visits to hospitals and jails to bring cheers to the inmates. The club also participated in the first national convention in Davao City in October, 1976.

A new age for Iloilo Zonta came with the incumbency of Ruth Tirol Cocjin (now Jarantilla) in 1979. The club adopted the inmates of the Puluy-an Sang Pamatan-on, a detention facility for youthful offenders, and rendered regular services thereat.

In 1980, the Club teamed up with the University of San Agustin and built the Tilipunan Community Center. Tilipunan, meaning a gathering place, became home to Zonta Club Iloilo City I. It also became the venue for most of its civic projects for the community of Tanza with 12 barangays: day care services, livelihood and training for parents and the youth. With Tilipunan, Zonta projects became more focused and integrated daycare services for children, medical-dental services, sports, cultural and social events and many more. Monthly Zonta meetings were also held there.
