We will stress E Empowerment through educational opportunities. We support fellowship for members who serve their communities, their nation and the world. During 2016-2018 we

participated in the area6 meeting to present series of experiential learning of empowerment education in various communities in Thailand. We network with Zonta Pitsanulok and the Association for the Promotion of the Women Status and the Foundation for Research and Development in Human Sexuality developing innovation in counseling service providers in communities towards development resilience of women in communities.

During 2017, we plan series of lectures to be delivered to our members and network, especially in the area of gender mainstreaming which is proposed in the new Thai constitution.

Our Club History

Starting with Zonta Bangkok 6 founding president, Zontian Saisom Wongsasulak and her strong deliberation to assist HIV/AIDS mothers (with economic hardship) through provision of education, shelter and empowerment for their children. Ability of these marginalized children to withstand challenges in life depends on self confidence through trust and compassion provided by schools. Zonta Bangkok 6 established Chalerm Pra Kiat 48 Pansa in Lumpoon Province on 8 rai of land donated by Zontian Bangkok6, Saipin Paholyothin, our own past president.

The school is sustainable and develop into one of the most popular schools the north. Each year, life skill education taught by medical students networking with Zonta Chiangmai, added experience to counseling teachers.

Since many members of the club are interested in enhancing participation of communities into local science education, during 2009, King Prachatipok Institute provided grant to empower students in Klaeng Wittaya Staworn to assist communities in environment quality education. Z club was formed and the teacher advisor received the Green World award for this innovation. We are very proud of them.

Our core members of the clubs such as Dr. Thawilwadee Bureekul (director of the King Prachatipok Institute R/D division) is actively involved with community strengthening, and our new constitution will have an impact on women running for parliament seat, we set up series of lectures on updates jointly with the Social Entrepreneur program of the Association for the Promotion of the Women Status to educate public and members who serve their communities.
